We are happy to inform everyone that with our recent visit from the care inspector, we have received out numbers, which are as follows;

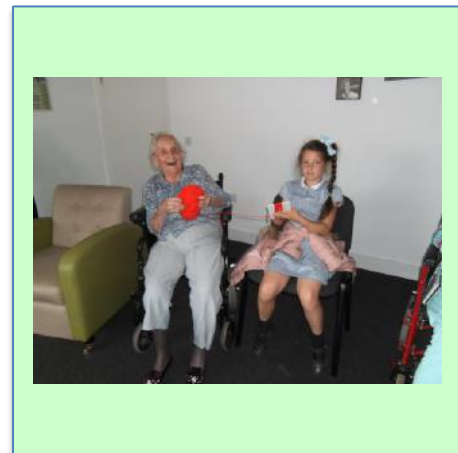
